 <p>Key safe Keep a key near the entrance to save time in urgent situations</p>	 <p>4-transmitter Operates up to 4 doors, gates, barriers,...</p>	 <p>Receiver Receives signal of nearby transmitters</p>	 <p>Rolling code receiver Users can be added and deleted individually on the display</p>	 <p>Active antenna Extend the reach of your receiver</p>
 <p>Keypad Get access by entering an agreed upon code</p>	 <p>Mechanical keypad Keypad without batteries or electricity</p>	 <p>Card To hold near card reader to open door or gate</p>	 <p>Badge To hold near card reader to open door or gate</p>	 <p>Card reader Scans cards or tags to grant access</p>
 <p>Gatestate module Eases user management and maintenance</p>	 <p>Cellphone remote control Use a cellphone as transmitter</p>	 <p>Cellphone intercom Use a cellphone to answer the intercom</p>	 <p>Videophone Combines the screen and intercom to answer visitors</p>	 <p>Intercom Answer visitors at your entrance</p>
 <p>Key switch Opens or closes gates, doors and barriers with a simple key turn</p>	 <p>Entrahome Operate your gates and doors with an app from all over the world</p>	 <p>Ultrasonic sensor Detects vehicles through sonic waves</p>	 <p>Loop detectors Detects vehicles at the entrance using sawn magnets</p>	 <p>Push button Get access by pushing the button</p>
